



## Criteria for a Benton County Business Assistance Grant Program (Administered by the Benton Economic Partnership, Inc.)

- For-profit business may apply, excluding any adult-oriented businesses or establishments whose primary trade is in gambling, tobacco or tobacco-related product sales
- 2. Business must have its primary physical location in Benton County
- 3. Business in operation since September 1, 2019 or earlier
- 4. Employ 50 or fewer people
- 5. Registered with the MN Secretary of State
- 6. Have no delinquent property taxes prior to the first half payable 2020 due date
- 7. Chain-type businesses must be owned by corporations, partnerships or individuals located in Benton County
- 8. Be in "good standing" with the State of MN and City or Township in which the business is located
- 9. Can demonstrate an adverse economic impact directly related to the COVID-19 pandemic and able to provide documentation of such impact
- 10. Grants may not be used to pay rent, mortgages, payroll costs or other costs when such costs were reimbursed by federal Paycheck Protection Program Loan funds
- 11. Funding granted will not duplicate funding received from a City, Township or other sources for pandemic relief (but receiving funding from a City or Township will not necessarily exclude the applicant from receiving County CARES funds)
- 12. Grant recipients will agree to allow an inspection and copying of business records requested by the BEP and County to satisfy subrecipient monitoring requirements
- 13. Grant recipients acknowledge that if any funding is later deemed ineligible, the recipient business shall be responsible for any collection costs associated with recovering CARES funds.
